CAMP CHANGES LIVES

Ongoing research shows how increasingly important it is for kids to spend time outside. Time at summer camp is an important investment in the physical, mental, and spiritual welfare of our children and has lasting impacts on individuals' relationships with God, other people, and all of creation.



THE TYPICAL CAMP EXPERIENCE

LOMIK offers resident camp experiences where relationships with God and one another are explored at one of our three unique sites. We believe that the outdoor setting of God's creation offers exciting ways to grow in faith, hope, and independence. Campers experience a wide variety of activities in small and large groups: Bible study, games, hiking, swimming, arts and crafts, devotions, worship, campfires, music, and so much more! We engage in activities that help develop the mental, emotional, social, and physical health of the campers. Our programs seek to create an appreciation of nature and foster stewardship to minimize our impact on the environment, all while providing a fun, exciting week of camp!



SUMMER STAFF

LOMIK summer programs are staffed by fun, enthusiastic, college-aged counselors who love working with kids. Many of our summer staff grew up attending camp and want to give kids the same great Christian community experience they were given. They come highly recommended and are good students with a positive, appreciative attitude towards life. They use good judgment in the care of themselves and others. Their Christian faith is a real factor in their everyday lives; their works and actions make them good role models; and they work well as a team.



CLASSIC CAMPS

All camp programs are designed to be age appropriate.
(See the calendar on the back page for dates.)

Pilgrim – A great first camp experience for those entering grades 1-3. The shortened week provides four busy days of general camp activities geared towards a young age group. Smaller groups allow for extra individual attention. **\$250**

Super Pilgrim – A week-long experience offered for the more mature 1-3 graders who are ready for a full camp week. **\$350**

Pioneer – A lively week packed with activities for upper elementary youth entering grades 4-6. **\$375**

Trailblazer – A week geared for young teens entering grades 7-9 involving more advanced activities and more individual choice for than younger campers. **\$375**

Our advising camp physician suggests kids should become acclimated to the summer heat and humidity by playing outside (ex. riding a bike, kicking a soccer ball around) for at least an hour a day for two weeks prior to coming to camp.

Grandparent Week –

Grandparents of pilgrim campers stay in modern, comfortable retreat facilities and are a background presence with no responsibilities. Adults may join in the camp meals, activities, and campfires and take time to relax and enjoy nature on their own. Pilgrim campers enjoy a short week of camp and stay in cabins supervised by our college-aged staff. **\$185**

Trailblazer Servant – (entering grades 7-9)

Along with the usual camp activities, campers will take part in daily service projects with their counselors, both on and off the Lake Luther site. **\$375**

Servant Leaders – (entering grades 10-12)

Blending service opportunities around camp with leadership training, we aim to help older campers and equip them to serve. In addition to having lots of fun, our staff will lead campers through team building activities, learning sessions, service projects, and opportunities to put their leadership training into action. **\$375**

Reading Camp – (entering grades 3-6)

A camp experience with a focus on improving reading skills. Mornings are set aside for small group learning led by volunteer teachers. The rest of the day is filled with fun camp activities. Teacher referral and test scores are requested prior to camp. **FREE**

Confirmation Camp – (entering grades 6-9)

A week that combines two hours of study each day with your pastor and confirmation class, plus all of the fun camp activities. Confirmation campers register as a group (coordinated by your local congregation). **\$375**

Senior High Ped-Pad – (entering grades 9-12)

Join us for a bicycling, canoeing, and tenting adventure around and between our two northern camps, beginning and ending at Lake Luther. Participants will need a good, multi-speed bike and helmet. Don't have one? Tell us when you register and we will provide a bike and/or helmet. This program is not designed as a serious athletic challenge—the focus is fun! **\$400**

Hiking & Caving Adventure – (entering grades 7-9)

Join us for a week of hiking around beautiful Lutheran Hills and two days of caving in southern Indiana. Participants should bring a backpack. Don't have one? Tell us when you register and we will provide a backpack. This program is not designed as a serious athletic challenge—the focus is fun! **\$425**

Performing Arts Camp – (entering grades 5-10)

A camp experience for youth who love singing and performing. Campers spend 4-5 hours each day working on a high-energy, Christian musical. The final production is presented to parents and family members at Friday afternoon pick up. **\$375**

Senior High Adventure – (entering grades 9-12)

A Sr. High opportunity designed to let campers experience a wide variety of outdoor activities which are more in depth than during our regular camp program. Boating, hiking, camping, cooking, and climbing give campers a chance to test their limits and gain new experiences amidst God's creation. **\$425**

Red River Gorge Adventure – (entering grades 9-12)

Are you ready for the next level of adventure? Join us for our Red River Gorge Adventure! We'll start by hiking at Lutheran Hills then travel to Red River Gorge in Kentucky for two nights and three days of tent camping, rock climbing, hiking, zip-lining, and cooking over a fire. This trip is beginner friendly, so there is no experience required. This week will challenge high school students to step outside of their comfort zone while growing closer to God in the scenic outdoors. Spots are limited. **\$600**

FAME* – (entering grades 3-9)

Festival of Arts and Music for Elementary (FAME) camp is the only week-long overnight fine arts camp for talented artistic students ages 8-16 in northern Indiana. A week-long residential arts camp presents the FAME cultural focus in dance, drama, music, and art by an outstanding faculty of arts educators. The program offers an opportunity for artistic students to further their current artistic study and to participate in an artist youth community. FAME classes of voice, instrumental, musical theater, visual arts drama, dance, literature, and storytelling are interspersed with camp activities including swimming, archery, canoeing, horseback riding, mud hiking, and more. Nightly talent sharing provides ample opportunities for performance, fun, and camaraderie. **\$450**
