ANOTHER GREAT SUMMER!

Those who attend summer camp know the great things that happen throughout the week. Outside in God's creation, a step removed from technology and the normal stresses and strains of daily life, campers have many and various opportunities to grow closer to God, test their own limits, and develop meaningful relationships with staff and fellow campers.



The summer of 2022 saw continued "post-pandemic" recovery as LOMIK served 537 campers, 222 of whom attended for their first time. Reflecting our diversity and openness to all, 295 were Lutheran, 100 were non-Lutheran, and 119 had no church affiliation. Campers and staff came to our three sites from 9 different states, and seven different congregations brought a taste of camp to their local setting through our traveling Luther Road program. 313 campers received partial or full scholarships to the amount of \$27,375 making it possible for no one to be denied a camp experience for financial need.
