LOMIK CAMP EXPERIENCES

LOMIK offers residential camp experiences where relationships with God and one another are explored at one of our three amazing sites. Campers experience a wide variety of activities in small and large groups. Bible study, games, hiking, swimming, arts and crafts, devotions, worship, campfires, & music all play a part in the excitement of a week at camp. All camp programs are designed to be age appropriate.



Summer programs are staffed by fun, enthusiastic, college-aged counselors who love working with kids. Many of our staff grew up attending camp and want to give your kids the same great Christian community experience they had. They come highly recommended and have positive attitudes towards life. They use good judgement in the care of themselves and others. Their Christian faith is a real factor in their every day lives; their words and actions make them good role models and team players.



Camp is physically active. Campers should become acclimated to the summer heat and humidity by playing outside (riding a bike, kicking a soccer ball around, etc.) prior to coming to camp.

Pilgrim Camp (entering grades 1-3) is a shortened week packed full of faith-filled fun! During this Sunday-Wednesday, campers participate in arts & crafts, field games, Bible studies, swimming, campfires, and more! This is a perfect way to introduce your 1st-3rd grade child to the joy of camp and for them to experience the love of God while being surrounded by nature. **\$275 Offered at: Lake Luther, Lutherwald, Lutheran Hills**

For those young campers who just cannot get enough, we also offer a **Super-Pilgrim** (entering grades 1-3) option. Super Pilgrims stay the full week Sunday-Friday. **\$375 Offered at: Lake Luther, Lutherwald, Lutheran Hills**

Grandparent Camp is a program that runs in conjunction with pilgrim camp week. Grandparents can sign up to come the same week as their Pilgrim camper and enjoy a relaxing week in the camp environment. Grandparents stay in one of our adult-friendly retreat facilities, and can join in as much of the camp fun as they choose. Some adult programming will be available. 
Classic Camps (see calendar on back page for dates)







SPECIALTY CAMPS (see calendar on back page for dates)






Foundation for Art and Music for Elementary (FAME)* (entering grades 3-9) FAME camp is the only week-long overnight fine arts camp for talented artistic students ages 8-16 in northern Indiana. FAME camp presents a cultural focus on dance, drama, music, and art led by an outstanding faculty of arts educators. The program offers an opportunity for artistic students to further their current artistic study and to participate in a community of young artists. FAME classes of voice, instrumental, musical theater, visual arts, drama, dance, literature and story-telling are interspersed with camp activities including swimming, canoeing, mud-hiking and more. 

Red River Gorge Adventure (off-site) (entering grades 9-12) Are you ready for the next level of adventure? We'll start by hiking at Lutheran Hills, then travel to Red River Gorge in Kentucky for two nights and three days of tent camping, rock climbing, hiking, zip-lining, and cooking over a fire. This trip is beginner friendly, so there is no experience required.
