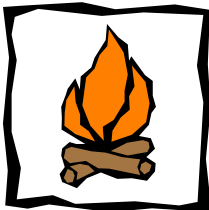
WATER ROCKET WORKSHOP

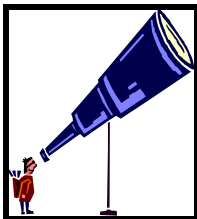
JUGGLING WORKSHOPS

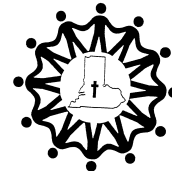
