Lake Luther – July 5-10

“Next Generation” runs from Monday-Saturday and is for older high school students (entering grades 11-12) who are interested in learning about summer camp program leadership—and possibly serving as summer camp leaders when they are in college. The event is for the 3 camps of Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Indiana-Kentucky—Lutheran Hills, Lake Luther and Lutherwald—but is held only at Lake Luther (Angola IN).

The Program: Participants are involved in 10 leadership workshops, daily Bible study and give our staff assistance in general camp activities at Lake Luther's AMH Camp for mentally handicapped adults that runs concurrently with the “Next Generation” program.

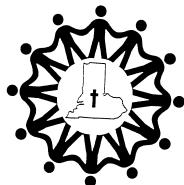

The Cost: Registration is \$295 which includes meals, housing and training materials.
