Serving Full-Time Since 2006 Bernards Retire As Lutherwald Managers

For the past 7 years, Don & Sue Bernard have provided hospitality to thousands of Lutherwald retreat visitors and summer campers. Together they have been instrumental in turning Lutherwald into a nationally-recognized 'showcase camp ' and special destination for vistors. LOMIK Director, Mark Radloff, tells this story...

"It was a hot day in August 2002 and camp was over for the summer. I stopped by Lake Luther to check in with Dick Hagen, our camp manager. He was eating lunch with his wife Doris and some guy I had never seen before. Dick introduced me that day to Don Bernard, a recently retired Ft Wayne school teacher and member of St Matthew Lutheran Church, who had come up to help with some projects. 'Don showed up a few weeks back to volunteer his time. He's been a great help around here,' I remember Dick telling me.

Summer turned to fall and Don continued to faithfully show up at camp weekly to help not only Dick at Lake Luther, but also Larry Hamrick, our manager at Lutherwald.

Dick called me one day in December and said, 'Mark, is there money in next year's budget to hire Don part-time? We need a guy like him more than one day a week to help catch up on all the work that needs to be done around here and over at Lutherwald.' I thought about it for about two seconds and agreed that bringing Don onboard was something we could and should do.

Little did we know at the time that Dick would suffer a fatal heart attack that next month, just days before Don officially began working for LOMIK. Everyone in our camp family deeply felt the loss of our friend and co-worker. But Don picked up where Dick left off, working on repairs and improvements at the camps.

In spring 2006, we said goodbye to Larry & Margie Hamrick as they accepted positions with the Lutheran camps in their home state of South Carolina. We offered Don the full -time position at Lutherwald. 'Let me check with Sue and see if we can do this to-gether,' Don said. So that's the story of how Don & Sue began working as a team as Lutherwald camp managers."

Here's the good news...The Bernards will continue to be involved. Don will work parttime as LOMIK Maintenance Manager, responsible for maintenance oversight at all 3 of our camps—and Sue will help out as the need arises with special events.

New Construction in 2014 Lutheran Hills Update

Planning is in the early stages, but the LOMIK Board of Directors are moving forward with plans to give Lutheran Hills a new look in 2014.

This winter and spring will see the demolition of GINKO/GUEST HOUSE, replacing it with a new facility (similar to the Jerusalem house built at Lutherwald in 2012) that will be ready for the summer.

Also in the works for 2014 are plans to begin the first phase of renovating SHEDRON LODGE (left), giving it an outside facelift and reconfiguring/updating the interior—where it will accommodate up to 24 overnight guests.

History: Rev Fred Hanes was President of the United Lutheran Church when Lutherwald was established in 1949. Pastor Hanes, instrumental in arranging the purchase of the Lutherwald camp property, was honored through the naming of Hanes Lodge, Lutherwald's main camp facility, in 1955.

History: Pastor Rod & Martie Willeke have been long-time supporters of Lake Luther and former campground members. The endowment was established on the occasion of Pastor Willeke's 50th ordination anniversary by St Mark's and Risen Savior congregations.

• KEMPSKI RETREAT CENTER Endowment

History: The Kempski Retreat Center was named in 1986 to honor Rev Ralph Kempski, Bishop of the Indiana-Kentucky Synod from 1979-1998. The retreat center was built as a result of the Greater Lutheran Outdoor Witness (GLOW) campaign, a synod-wide outdoor ministry fundraising effort in the mid-1980s.

• Bishop James R. Stuck SCHOLARSHIP Endowment

Established: 2010 by the Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Indiana-Kentucky Board of Directors.

History: Bishop James R. Stuck served the Indiana-Kentucky Synod ELCA from 1998-2010, a time of unprecedented growth for our camps. Bishop Stuck has been a life-long avid supporter of Lutheran Hills, Lake Luther and Lutherwald. On the occasion of Bishop Stuck's retirement, the LOMIK Board of Directors announced the establishment of this fund in his honor at the 2010 Indiana-Kentucky Synod Assembly.

• Dr. George & Tiffiny Mansfield READING CAMP Endowment

Purpose: To provide an annual gift to help cover costs associated with Reading Camp camper scholarships and program needs. Established: 2011by Dr George & Tiffini Mansfield

History: Dr Mansfield, alarmed in learning that some states base their future prison population estimates on the literacy failure rate of current elementary school children, was motivated to establish this fund when he learned LOMIK was addressing this issue through its Reading Camp program. Although Dr & Mrs Mansfield, members of St Paul's/Seymour, have been blessed with children of their own who do not struggle with reading, they feel passionately that children be provided opportunity to achieve their potential.

Established: 2011 by wife Carole and sons John & David.

History: Pastor Herbon served three congregations in Indiana—Calvary/Angola, St John/Ft Wayne, Trinity/Goshen. All three congregations were instrumental in the founding of Lake Luther.
