PILGRIM CAMP is a half-week (3:00 pm Sunday afternoon through Wednesday lunch) for children entering grades 1-3. It's a busy three days of activities for young campers led by our college-aged summer camp staff with games, crafts, water activities, Bible lesson time and campfire programs.

GRANDPARENTS are welcome to come to camp (knowing their grandchildren are in good hands throughout the day and night with our college-aged camp staff) and be a background presence with no responsibilities, just to be near grandchildren and attend meals and campfire programs with them.

Housing: Pilgrim campers stay in cabins with their college-aged counselor. Grandparents are housed in the comfortable Kempski Retreat Center (Lutherwald), Shedron Lodge (Lutheran Hills) or one of the guest cabins (Lake Luther).

Cost: \$115. per grandparent / \$190. per grandchild.
