A Summer Ministry Program of Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Indiana-Kentucky

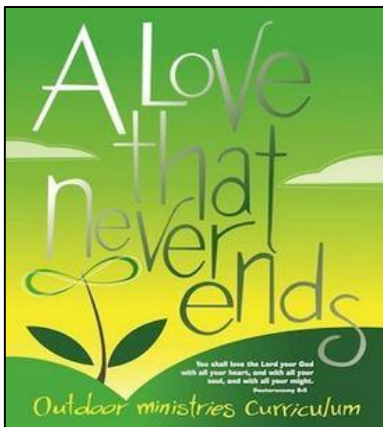
LUTHER ROAD is a “summer camp program on wheels” where the benefits of camp at Lutheran Hills, Lutherwald, and Lake Luther—worship, games, Bible stories, arts & crafts and recreation—come to your church. It is designed for up to 50 youth entering grades 1-6 and the program runs at your church from Sunday evening through Friday noon. Each team arrives with 5 college-aged staff who work closely with a “Local Coordinator” and volunteers from your church. The cost is \$3,000.

Loving God and others sounds simple, but living it out gets more complicated. People of faith have often been called to do difficult things—to pack up and go when called, to speak difficult truths in difficult situations, to believe in God’s promises, and to love even our enemies. 2015 COVENANT

We covenant with Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Indiana-Kentucky (LOMIK) to conduct a LUTHER ROAD Day Camp program and agree to the following:

- To provide local leadership including a local coordinator, a newsletter editor, and daily volunteers (including one program volunteer for every 10 campers and one for every “special needs” child) and provide for publicity, registration, a daily newsletter, camper lunches and snacks.
- To welcome the Luther Road staff and provide them with housing, meals.
- To compensate LOMIK \$3,000 for the camp week and provide a \$500 deposit with this Covenant— with the balance due on the last day of camp.

We further understand that Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Indiana-Kentucky will provide us with:

- 5 college-aged staff that are activity and Bible curriculum-trained, program materials and supplies to conduct the day camp program--and lots of enthusiasm!
