Over 600 Volunteers Participated in Camp Service Projects in 2015

We Love Our Camp Volunteers!

Providing "opportunities for service" is a core value of LOMIK's mission.

Our volunteers do a lot—from general camp maintenance (painting, splitting firewood, spring cleaning, landscape work) to off-site projects that benefit the surrounding communities.

In 2015, over 600 volunteers participated in 15 service opportunities at Lutheran Hills, Lake Luther and Lutherwald, including:

Pigeon River Clean Up. A crew of 8 high school and college volunteers collected over 100 lbs. of trash along a 5 mile section of the Pigeon River in Steuben County in July.

"Back To School Day" School Supply Give-Away. Lake Luther partnered with Project HELP, Thrivent Financial, Walgreens and other Angola businesses to provide basic school supplies to needy families. 32 current/former camp staff and friends of Lake Luther gathered to serve nearly 400 kids from 4 school districts.

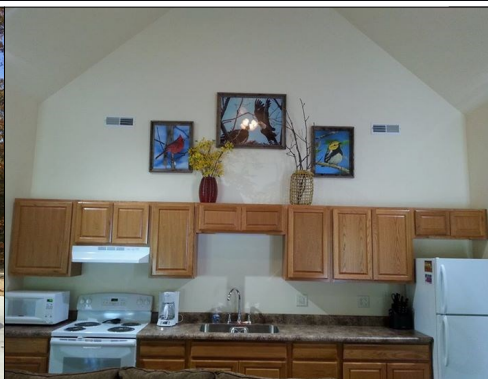
Youth Cabin Roof Replacement. Over a dozen volunteers put a new metal roof on the Redeemer/Hosanna cabin at Lake Luther in early September.

"Bear Creek Village" at Lutheran Hills officially opened this fall with the completion of the second retreat cottage made possible with a generous gift from Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Indianapolis. The Bear Creek Village facilities are open year-round. Each spacious cottage houses up to 8 people complete with kitchen, dining and meeting areas, 4 bedrooms, a bathroom and a shower room. The construction of a 3rd cottage will begin shortly.

Ensuring A Strong Future For Camp Ministry **LOMIK "Named Endowment" Q&A**



What is a LOMIK Named Endowment?

It's a gift of \$10,000 or more, invested and managed by Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Indiana- Kentucky, that provides annual income for camp ministry. Essentially, it's a gift that keeps on giving.

Why is the gift "Named?"

Because the endowment gift is established:

- in memory of a friend or family member
- to honor an individual
- as a family project with the intent to add to the principal going forward
- to fund a particular camp program
- to fund camp maintenance at a particular camp or camp building.

Who have been honored with Named Endowments?

Five people have been honored or memorialized to date:

- Jim Greener, volunteer Lake Luther maintenance worker
- Pastor Fred Hanes, responsible for the 1949 Lutherwald property purchase
- Pastor Tom Herbon, longtime supporter of Lake Luther
- Bishop Jim Stuck, upon his retirement from Indiana-Kentucky Synod
- Pastor Rod Willeke, upon the 50th anniversary of his ordination

So a Named Endowment is given for a SPECIFIC PURPOSE?

Yes. LOMIK currently has 12 accounts with a value of \$185,500 in protected principal. Six of these endowments provide CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS, three provide a GENERAL GIFT to LOMIK, two provide support to CAMP PROPERTY, and one was established to support a CAMP PROGRAM (Reading Camp).

Instead of establishing a Named Endowment myself, can I contribute to an existing one?

Yes. A gift of any amount can be added to an existing Named Endowment.
