Day Camp is a program for kids entering grades 1-6 where parents set the specific drop-off and pick-up times each day. The program includes lunch each day, and is full of camp activities—Bible study, games, swimming, crafts, canoeing/kayaking—all conducted by our "super" college-aged summer camp staff.

Cost: \$150.

Registration is easy. Pre-register on-line at www.lomik.org and then kids arrive at camp on Sunday at 3 pm for onsite check-in and a two-hour kickoff program with their age group.

Day campers arrive each Monday morning when it's most convenient for parents. Breakfast is at 8:30 am, so parents normally drop-off their kids immediately before or after breakfast. We are totally flexible. Parents also choose what time to pick up each day.

As far as what to bring, we suggest that each child bring a book backpack or small bag that has a swim suit, towel, real shoes for running around, sunscreen, and reusable water bottle.

The camp week ends on Friday and concludes at 2 pm with a closing program. Parents are invited!
